SHEET METAL SUPERVISOR

PRIMARY PURPOSE

Supervises and coordinates activities of work crew engaged in the fabrication and installation of sheet metal products and equipment.

TYPICAL DUTIES AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Select gauge and type of sheet metal according to product being fabricated and knowledge of metal.
- 2. Supervise and coordinate activities of assigned craft workers.
- 3. Interpret specifications blueprints, and job orders as needed for area of supervision.
- 4. Direct installation of assemblies in building or work site.
- 5. Interpret company policies to workers, and enforce safety regulations.
- 6. Establish and adjust work sequences to meet construction schedule using knowledge of capacities of equipment and assigned personnel.
- 7. May study schedules and estimate worker-hour requirements for completion of job.
- 8. Analyze and resolve work problems.
- 9. Maintain time records.
- 10. May make cost estimates for contracts.
- 11. Understand shop math.
- 12. Work skillfully with tools, metals, and machines.
- 13. Visualize three-dimensional objects from drawings, sketches, or blueprints.
- 14. Work within precise limits and standards of accuracy.
- 15. Perform a variety of duties which may change often, and rate information using measurable standards.
- 16. Lift objects of varying weights.
- 17. Perform work from scaffolding, ladders or other structures.
- 18. Perform work overhead, beneath structure, and from various other positions as required by working conditions.
- 19. Detect, recognize and respond to dangerous conditions or situations.
- 20. Appropriate journeyman experience required.
